Immediate issue An important resource to the greater Sacramento region since 1920, the ISB now has a critical funding problem. RCCTV is the ISB primary funding source and RCCTV is suffering a \$4,000 net loss per month.

PLC / VCI have been asked to assist in the immediate development of new directions and funding sources for the ISB and RCCTV. To that end, PLC and local attorney Burl Waits have donated video conferencing equipment to RCCTV and agreed to spearhead the creation of innovative new visions for RCCTV and ISB. You are urged to consider joining the project team.

Exciting Opportunity One opportunity we are currently investigating is to gather community forces to bid on a \$2.9 million Request for Proposal (RFP) from the Public Utilities Commission (PUC). The project is designed to be a statewide program to assist individuals and organizations with language challenges better understand the communication systems. Most of the PUC funding is mandated for community organizations. We are seeking contacts with organizations that might need these services.
